User Module: Adding an Image to your Gallery

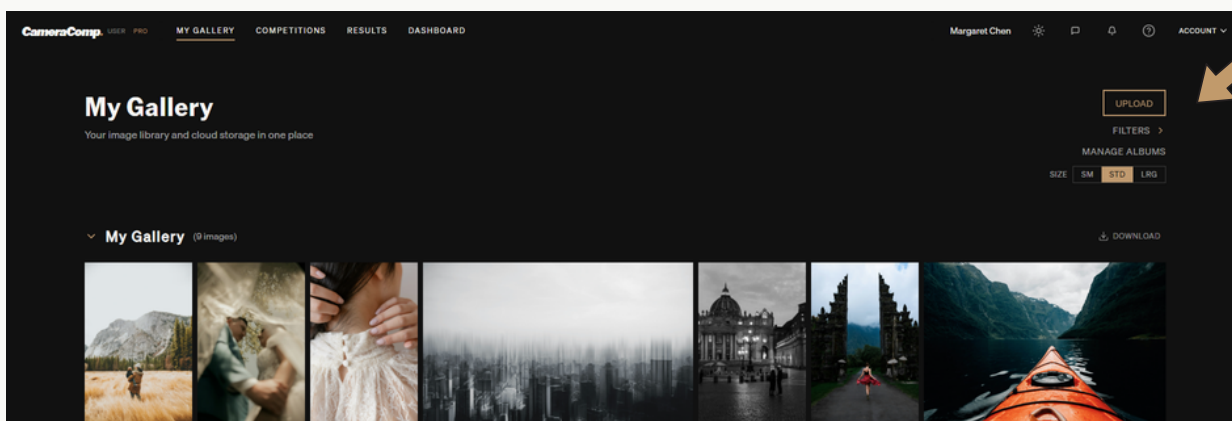
Your gallery is your private photo library.

Upload images to your gallery first. This will enable you to select images to enter a competition or build your portfolio.

Open your Gallery

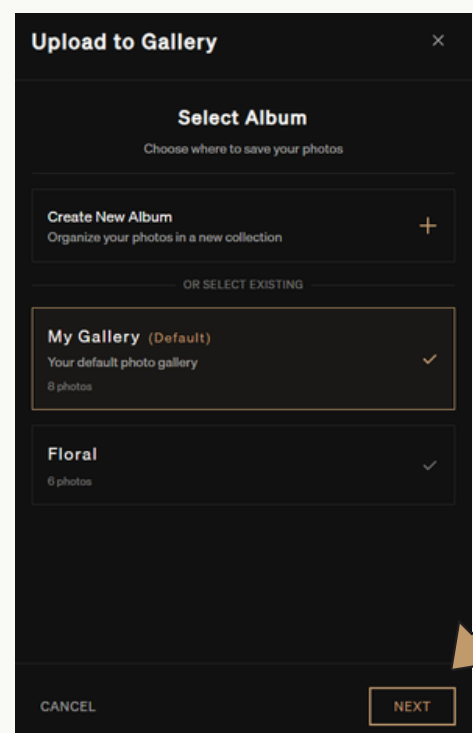
- Choose MY GALLERY from the top navigation.
- Click the UPLOAD button (top right).

Choose an album

- The Upload to Gallery panel slides in (screen right).
- Your default 'My Gallery' album is already selected.
- Click 'NEXT' to use the default, or 'CREATE NEW ALBUM' to organise your images into separate albums.



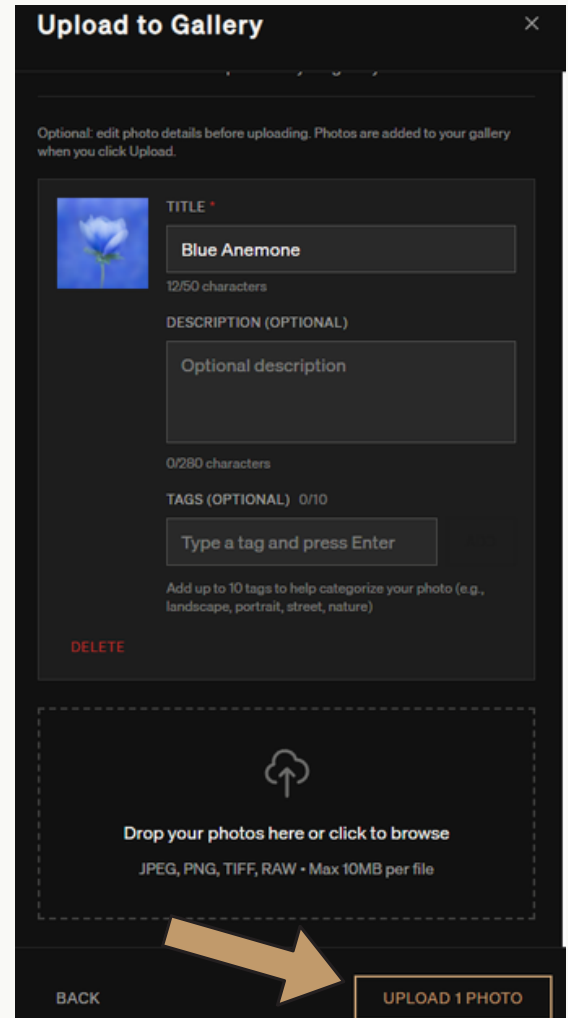

Add your Photos

- Click the 'Drop your photos here or click to browse' box to choose your file/s.
- Give your image/s a title.
- Add description for your image/s if you choose. These are not required, but can make images easier to find later.
- Click the 'UPLOAD' button when done.

- You'll see a quick progress bar, then a confirmation. The panel closes on its own and your photo is now in your gallery, ready to enter into competitions or add to your portfolio.

- ★ Adding several images at once? Give them each a title then upload in one go to save time.
- ★ If you have uploaded the same image twice, CameraComp. will spot the duplicate and ask you to confirm so you don't store it twice.
- ★ Entering or removing an image from a competition does not delete it from your gallery.
