User Module: Enter a Competition

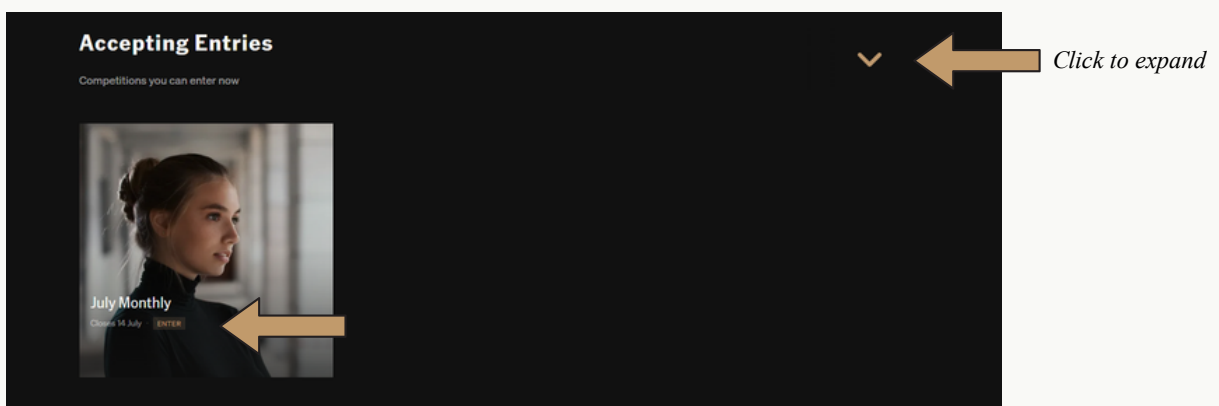
Once you have added images to your Gallery you can enter competitions.

Find a Competition

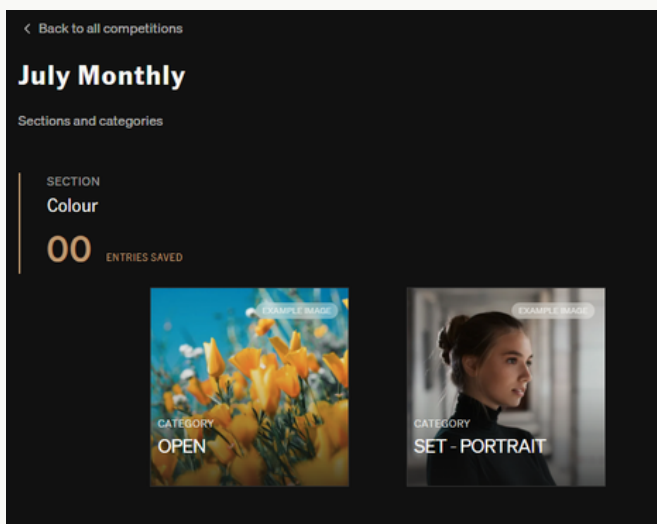
- Choose COMPETITIONS from the top navigation menu.
- The ‘Accepting Entries’ section lists everything open to you right now. Click the arrow to expand if needed.
- On the thumbnail, you will see ENTER (you haven’t entered yet), CONTINUE (you have a submission in draft) or VIEW (already submitted). Click ENTER to begin.

Choose a Category

- You’ll see the competition’s sections and categories, with how many entries you’ve saved in each. Click a category tile to start (or add to) an entry.

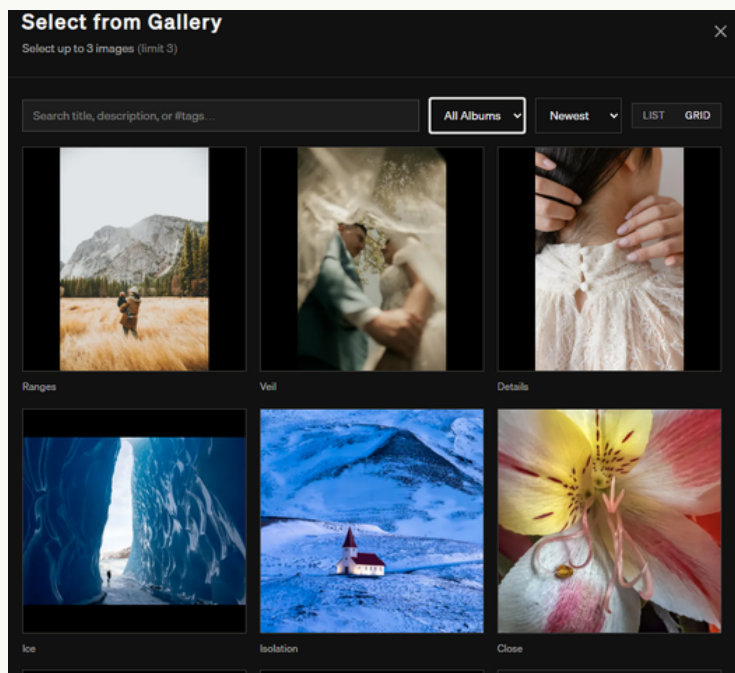


Choose the Section and Category to add images

Add a Photo from your Gallery

- Click ADD PHOTO and the 'Select from Gallery' picker opens.
- Filter by album, then click the photo you want.
- Click 'CONFIRM' to attach it,

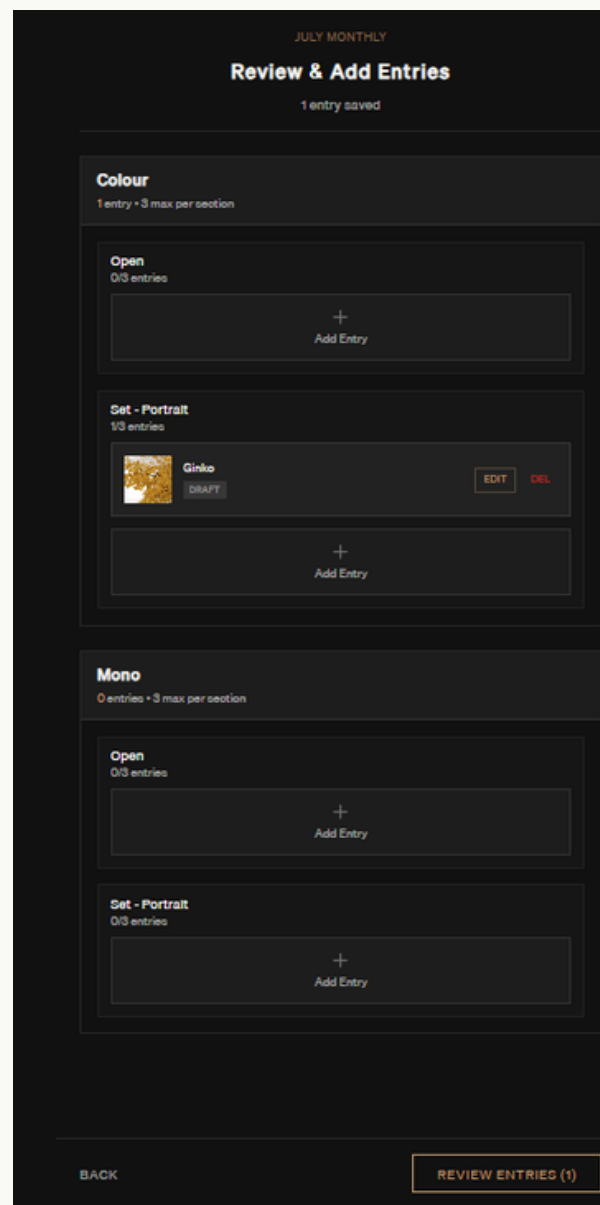


Selecting an image from the gallery

Review and Title your Entries

- The review panel will display allowing you to see your selected entries.
- Click 'Edit' to change the titles if needed.
- Click 'Add entry' to add additional images.
- Under each category heading, you will see how many images you have entered against the maximum allowable for the competition.
- When you have finished adding entries, click the 'REVIEW ENTRIES' button.

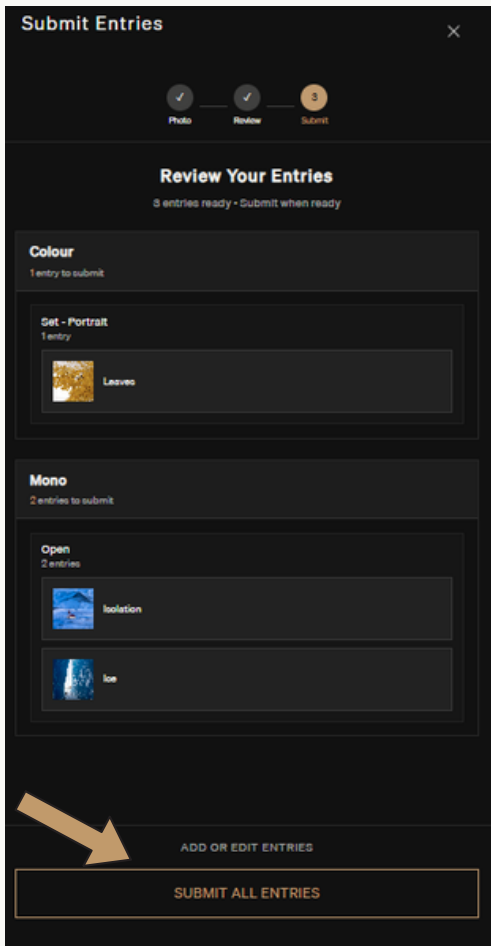


Review Panel showing entry progress

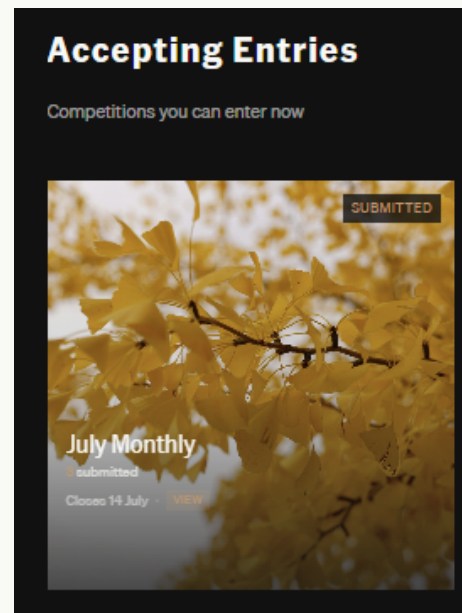

Submit Entries

- Click SUBMIT ALL ENTRIES and confirm your submission.
- The competition tile will now show as 'submitted'. While the competition is still open you can keep editing and re-submit. Once it closes, entries are locked.

Good to Know

- ★ Draft entries are private to you. Images are not entered until you Submit.
- ★ If you edit an entry after submission, remember to re-submit your entry so changes are reflected.
- ★ Removing an entry only takes it out of the competition. Your original photo stays safe in your gallery.
